

Toy Hauler Showdown — Genesis Supreme vs Grand Design Momentum

Toy haulers. Genesis Supreme on one side. Grand Design Momentum on the other. Both haul your jeep and your ATV. Different builds. Which one survives the abuse?

Round one — garage space. Genesis runs longer, more cargo room. Momentum runs a touch shorter but with smarter tie-down placement. Tie.

Round two — ramp door. Both rated for similar load capacity. Genesis uses heavier-duty hinges. Momentum uses lighter-duty but with a longer warranty. Tie.

Round three — generator placement. Genesis built-in onan in most models. Momentum offers as option. If you haul ATVs and need fuel runs — built-in is better. Genesis wins.

Round four — living quarters. Momentum has more residential finishes, better cabinetry, nicer kitchen. Genesis is more bare-bones but more durable. Personal preference — Momentum wins on comfort, Genesis on toughness.

Round five — price. Genesis runs eighty-five to one-twenty. Momentum runs ninety to one-thirty-five. Roughly equivalent per foot.
